The Impact of Your Support: Our Fundraising Initiatives

Proceeds from the fundraising gala will be directed toward three critical initiatives designed to provide immediate care, bridge a crucial service gap, and build a foundation for future excellence.

I. Care for Kids | Fundraising Goal: \$500,000

This initiative focuses on deploying funds immediately to improve diagnostics and care for children currently in treatment. Your support will help fund:

- Intraoral Scanner: An essential tool for creating accurate images of newborns with a facial cleft, enabling better surgical planning and outcomes. Estimated Cost: \$45,000
- **4DMD 3D Facial Scanner:** Advanced technology to capture functional images for speech analysis and document primary lip repair outcomes with growth. **Estimated Cost:** \$60,000
- Camp Zajac Experience: A chance for CCF patients and their siblings to build confidence and community at a specialized camp.
 Estimated Cost: \$100,000
- Critical Therapies: Funding for essential speech therapy and specialized dental care in private practice for patients who need it most.

II. Transition Care for Teens | Fundraising Goal: \$500,000

Each year, young adults with CCF differences age out of pediatric care and are left to navigate the complex adult healthcare system alone. This initiative addresses this critical gap.

• **The Need:** Currently, no organization is dedicated to servicing the needs of these young adults, jeopardizing their long-term health and



well-being. Access to funding for speech, social work, and specialized dental services are significant barriers.

• The Solution: We are creating a transitional clinic with a dedicated team of practitioners educated in adult CCF care. This program will provide continuity of care and develop clinical guidelines and patient resources to ensure a seamless transition.

III. Cleft & Craniofacial Centre of Excellence | Fundraising Goal: \$5,000,000

Our ultimate vision is to establish a state-of-the-art Centre of Excellence. The current clinic space is over-subscribed, leading to workflow inefficiencies and compromised patient experiences.

• The Vision: This ambitious project seeks to expand the current oversubscribed clinic space, allowing for increased patient visits, private consultations, education, clinical outcome research and state-of-the-art technology and equipment to promote excellence in care. The estimated budget for this centre is \$5 million, covering renovation, equipment, project management, and establishment of patient programs and patient services. This project represents a long-term investment in advanced healthcare infrastructure that will ultimately elevate the standard of care for generations to come.
